Yahweh's Personal Agent BBI IIc: 01

I. God is **invisible**, has **never been seen**, and **cannot be seen** by mortal humans; He cannot be confined to a place (1 Kings 8:27; 2 Chron. 2:5; 2 Chron. 6:18).

A. John 1:18 (NKJV) *No one has seen God at any time*. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

B. John 5:37 (NKJV) "And the Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. <u>You have</u> neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form.

C. John 6:46 (NKJV) "*Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from God; He has seen the Father.*"

D. Col. 1:15 (NKJV) He is the image of *the invisible God*, ...

E. 1 Tim. 1:17 (NKJV) Now to the King eternal, immortal, *invisible*...

F. 1 Tim. 6:16 (NKJV) ... who alone has immortality, dwelling in unapproachable light, <u>whom</u> <u>no man has seen or can see</u>, ...
G. Heb. 11:27 (NKJV) ... he endured as seeing <u>Him who is invisible</u>.

H. 1 John 4:12,20 (NKJV) *No one has seen God at any time*. ... for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love *God whom he has not seen?*

II. Who in the OT was called "God" and "Yahweh" who people saw with their eyes?

A. John 1:18 "the only-begotten Son"

B. John 14:9 "He who has seen Me has seen the Father"

C. Col. 1:15 "the image of the invisible God"

D. Heb. 1:3 "the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person"

III. Yahweh's Messenger bore Yahweh's NAME and title (God), and spoke as God.

A. Exod. 23:20-23 "My name is upon Him" (LXX) "in Him" (Heb)

B. Gen. 16:13 Hagar saw Yahweh's Messenger, but said she saw Yahweh!

C. Gen. 22:12 Yahweh's Messenger said to Abraham, "now I know that you fear <u>God</u>, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from <u>Me</u>." Yet the one who told Abraham to offer up Isaac was called "God" (vss. 1-3)

D. Gen. 28-48 "God" and "Yahweh" is said to have constantly aided Jacob. However, in Gen. 48:16 Jacob prayed that Yahweh's "*Messenger* who delivered me from all evils, bless these boys" (Joseph's sons).

E. Gen. 32:24-30 Yahweh's Messenger wrestled with Jacob, who changed his name to Israel. Jacob then asked Yahweh's Messenger His name, but He refused to give it (it remained hidden, a secret). Jacob then claimed, *"I have seen <u>God face to face</u> and my life is preserved."*

F. Exod. 3:2-22 Yahweh's Messenger appeared to Moses in the burning bush, and referred to Himself as "God." Moses was told to say to the Israelites, "*Yahweh God* of *your fathers, the <u>God</u> of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, <u>appeared to me</u> …" (v. 16), and Moses called Him "Yahweh" (vss. 4,7) and "God" (vss. 4,6,11,13,14,15).*

G. Exod. 14:19 The Messenger of God was in the pillar of cloud and fire, later called Yahweh (v. 24).

H. Judg. 2:1-2 Yahweh's Messenger claimed credit for the Exodus and the Mosaic Covenant: "<u>I led you</u> up from Egypt and brought you to the land of which <u>I swore</u> to your fathers; and <u>I said</u>, '<u>I will</u> never break <u>My covenant</u> with you.' And 'you shall make no covenant with the inhabitants of this land; you shall tear down their altars.' But you have not obeyed <u>My voice</u>."

I. Judg. 6:11-24 Yahweh's Messenger appeared to Gideon, sitting under a tree (v. 11). Then "<u>Yahweh turned to him</u> and spoke" (v. 14), and again "<u>Yahweh</u> said to him" (v. 16), and again "<u>Yahweh</u> said to him" (v. 23).

J. Judg. 13:3-23 Yahweh's Messenger appeared to Samson's parents: Manoah asked His name, but He replied, (v. 18) *"Why do you ask My name, seeing <u>it is a secret</u>?" (KJV – "a secret," JPS "hidden"). Yahweh's Messenger <i>"ascended into heaven"* (v. 20). Manoah said, *"We shall surely die, because we have seen <u>God</u>!" (v. 22).*

IV. Jesus is identified as Yahweh's "Messenger"

A. Isa. 9:6 the "Youth" who was begotten, the "Son" who was given, is called "the Messenger of Great Counsel" (LXX).

B. Mal. 3:1 the One for whom John the Baptist would prepare the way was *"the Messenger of the Covenant."*

1. Acts 7:30,35,38 identified the same "Messenger" who spoke to Moses in the burning bush also spoke the covenant on Mt. Sinai, yet Exod. 19:18 says Yahweh descended on Mt. Sinai and gave the covenant.

2. Heb. 3:1-6 indicates that Jesus build Moses' household.

C. Rom. 16:25; Col. 2:2 The "secret" concealed in the OT was Jesus Christ.

D. Gal. 4:14 Paul equated God's "Messenger" with "Christ Jesus."

E. 1 Tim. 2:5 There is only one "Mediator" between God and mankind – Jesus. If Yahweh's "Messenger" is not Jesus, then there are two "Mediators."

F. Rev. 1:1 Jesus is called God's "Messenger"
