- II. The Fall and Decline of the Creation
 - A. Sin brought death to all men (Gen. 2:15-17; Gen. 3:17-19; Rom. 5:12,17-19)
 - 1. Many "Creation" ministries claim there was no "death" of animals before Adam's sin. Is this true?
 - B. Sin & corruption escalated after Adam:
 - 1. Cain murdered Abel (Gen. 4:1-15).
 - 2. Cain's descendant, Lamech, was a murderer (Gen. 4:23).
 - 3. By Noah's day, violence filled the earth (Gen. 6:5-6, 11-12).
 - 4. Worse and worse (2 Tim. 3:1-13).
