Lesson 14 - David Becomes King

- 1. 1 Samuel 16:1-14 Samuel anoints David King while Saul was still king
 - A. The Spirit of God came upon David when anointed by the prophet
 - B. The Spirit of God left Saul @ the same time
 - C. Saul & David were called God's "Anointed" (Heb. Messiah; Gr. Christos)
- 2. 1 Samuel 16:15-23 David soothes Saul w/ music
 - A. vs. 16-17 "psallo" defined (to play a stringed instrument) David played by the Spirit of God, and wrote "Psalms" (Psalmos).
- 3. 1 Samuel 17:31-37; 40-51 David kills Goliath because the Spirit was with him, not Saul
- 4. 1 Samuel 18:6-12 Saul becomes jealous of David, and seeks to kill him
 - A. Chapters 18-23 Saul repeatedly hunts David, who must flee
 - 1. 23:29 David's hideout at EnGedi ("The Goats")
- 5. 1 Samuel 24:1-22 David spares Saul's life
- 6. 1 Samuel 25:1 Samuel dies, 1 Samuel 28 Saul in desperation turns to a medium
- 7. 1 Samuel 31 Saul's sad end
