Bereans Bible Institute Module IV – The Life of Christ Lesson 20 – The Last Passover

1. Events leading to Jesus' last Passover

A. John 12:1-11 Jesus arrived in Bethany 6 days before Passover (Saturday), a feast prepared, Mary anoints Jesus' **<u>feet</u>**, Judas alone objects.

B. Matt. 26:1-2 End of the Olivet Discourse (Tuesday – 3rd day counting from Sunday, <u>2 days before Passover</u> a second supper at the house of Simon, an unnamed woman anoints Jesus' head (vss. 3-16).

C. Luke 22:1-7 Satan "possessed" Judas <u>when he went out to confer with the</u> <u>chief priests</u>.

E. John 13:1The same supper was BEFORE the feast of Passover

1. Vs. 2 Satan had already put it in Judas' heart to betray Him (because of Jesus' rebuke)

2. Vss. 3-26 Jesus washed the disciples' feet (including Judas)

3. Vs. 27-30 After the piece of bread, Satan entered Judas, who went out to confer with the chief priests (Matt. 26:14-16)

4. Consequently, what is commonly called the "upper room discourse" was NOT the Passover, but 2 days earlier at the house of Simon the leper.

2. Judas the traitor attends the Passover with Jesus and the disciples.

A. Matt. 26:17-30 Jesus eats the Passover

B. Luke 22:14-38 Luke's account indicates that Judas took communion (v. 21)

C. Verses 28-30 the Kingdom belongs to those who continue with Christ through His trials (being rejected by the wicked, the religious, and even traitors among us).
