- 1. Jesus' trial before the Sanhedrin a farce
 - A. Matt. 26:57-62, Mark 14:52-59 False witnesses (not two or three witnesses)
 - 1. John 2:13-22 Jesus' actual prediction
 - a. Jesus' body was a "temple" of the Spirit of God (2 Cor. 5:18-19)
 - b. Paul drew the metaphor of the congregation (1 Cor. 6:19)
 - B. Matt. 26:63-66 Jesus condemned for "blasphemy" by His own testimony
 - 1. The charge was valid ONLY if it wasn't true.
 - 2. Their unbelief was the basis for the charge.
 - 3. They condemned Him because of "envy" (Matt. 27:18)
 - 4. Vs. 64: Jesus' 'blasphemous' prophecy (Dan. 7:13-14, 26-27; Rev. 6:12-17)
 - C. Jesus abused and mocked unlawfully (Matt. 26:67-68)
