## The Crucifixion (Part 2)

- I. Matt. 27:45-56 The events that occurred at 3:00pm when Jesus expired:
  - A. Matt. 27:45 Darkness for 3 hours ends.
  - B. John 19:25-28 Jesus entrusts His mother to John
  - C. Matt. 27:46 Jesus screamed out the opening words to Psalm 22
  - D. Matt. 27:48-49 The sour wine refused
  - E. Matt. 27:50 Jesus surrenders His "breath of life" back to the Father
  - F. Matt. 27:51 The earthquake and torn veil
  - G. Matt. 27:52-53 some of the graves of notable believers were opened
    - 1. Most likely the graves were opened by the earthquake.
    - 2. These were probably recently deceased believers who were known, and whose graves were known ("saints" means "holy ones," ritually pure, and likely refers to Christians {Acts 9:13})
    - 3. Their deaths are described as falling "asleep."
    - 4. They remained corpses throughout Jesus' interment, but "awakened" when He was resurrected, and exited their tombs.
    - 5. What became of them? What became of Lazarus, or others that Jesus raised? They lived out the remainder of their lives.
  - H. Matt. 27:54 The "centurion" and those with him are the ones mentioned in vss. 48-49.
  - I. John 19:31-37 Piercing His side (Ex. 12:46; Zech. 12:10)
