Lesson 10 – Rev. 2:18-29

- I. Thyatira (Known for dyed purple linen, Lydia of Philippi from there Acts 16:14)
 - A. Vs. 18 Jesus introduced Himself as 'The Son of God' ('Son of Man' in Rev. 1:13)
 - 1. 'Son of God' in Psalm 2:7 (cf. vs. 27)
 - 2. Eyes like fire, feet like molten brass, 'Son of God' in Dan. 3:23-28
 - B. Vs. 19 Jesus had observed deeds, love, service, faith, endurance & increasing works
 - C. Vs. 20 <u>Tolerate</u> Jezebel (1 Kings 16:28-33; 2 Kings 9:22-37)
 - 1. A Self-appointed prophetess (cf. Rev. 2:2 false Apostles)
 - a. A true prophetess, Deborah (Judges 4), Anna (Luke 2:36)
 - b. A false prophetess, Noadiah (Neh. 6:14)
 - 2. Allowed to teach b/c called herself a 'prophetess.' (1 Tim 2:8 3:2)
 - 3. Idolatry seduce Christians to 'fornicate,' eat food sacrificed to idols (cf. 2:14)
 - a. 1 Cor. 10:14-22 false prophets partake w/demons
 - D. Vs. 21-23 Jezebel = "Mystery Babylon" within the assembly (Rev. 18:1-11)
 - 1. Her time to repent has expired, judgment set.
 - 2. Those seduced by her still have time to repent (Rev. 18:4).
 - 3. "great tribulation" cf. 1 Cor. 11:30 vs. Rev. 3:10
 - 4. God will kill her children, the product of her idolatry
 - 5. I am the one searching the minds and hearts (Heb. 4:12-13)
 - E. Vs. 24-25
 - 1. Those who did not have this teaching, but instead call it "the depths of Satan."
 - 2. No rebuke, but exhortation: "Hold to what you have until I come."
 - F. Vs. 26-29 The Promise:
 - 1. Victorious, keeping Jesus' commandments to the end
 - a. Psalm 2:6-9 (cf. Rev. 3:21)
 - b. The Morning Star
 - 1. Jesus @ His first coming (Rev. 22:16)
 - 2. The SUN at the dawn of His Kingdom (Mal. 4:1)
