Module XI – Revelation

Lesson 18 –Revelation 6:9-11

- I. The 5th Seal persecution, the 'souls' of the martyrs
 - A. "Proof text" for "immortality of the soul" & "heaven" as destiny of righteous
 - 1. The altar is assumed to be in heaven
 - 2. "Souls" is assumed to be "ghosts," but no explanation for why they are "under the altar."
 - 3. In Ezek. 37:11-12, the "dry bones" cry out "Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!"
 - B. Vs. 9 The Blood of the Martyrs
 - 1. The altar of sacrifice is not in heaven, but outside the Temple, the place of killing, not to be confused with the "golden altar" of incense {Rev. 8:3}).
 - 2. "Souls" is **blood**, both man and beast (Gen. 9:4-5; Lev. 17:11-14)
 - 3. The souls/blood of animal sacrifices was poured out at the base of the altar (Lev. 4:7,18,34; Lev. 5:9).
 - C. Vs. 10 The "souls/bloods" call out to God for vengeance
 - 1. Abel's blood cried out for vengeance (Gen. 4:10-11)
 - 2. Abel was the prototype martyr (Luke 11:50-51)
 - D. Vs. 11 God's response"
 - 1. White robes given to them, "wedding garments" (Matt. 22:11-14; Rev. 19:7)
 - 2. They must "rest/sleep" a little longer (Dan. 12:2; Luke 8:52; John 11:11-14; 1 Cor. 15:51; 1 Thess. 4:14; Rev. 14:13)
 - 3. Their number must be completed, more martyrs to be slain by the Beast
 - 4. Martyrs resurrected and reigning (Rev. 20:4-6)
