Module XI - Revelation

Lesson 35 – Revelation 14:6-13

- I. The Declarations of the "Five Messengers" shows the sequence of Revelation
 - A. The First Messenger The First Half of the 70th Week (1,260 days, 2 Witnesses, first 4 Seals & Trumpets)
 - 1. Vss. 6-7
 - a. Repentance proclaimed to all nations:
 - 1. The PERMANENT Good Message concerns the Abrahamic Inheritance b. Worship the One who created all things, corresponding to the first 4 Trumpet judgments upon man's environment. (Rev. 8)
 - 1. sky 4th Trumpet: 1/3 sun, moon, stars darkened (Rev. 8:12-13)
 - 2. land 1st Trumpet: 1/3 trees, grass burned (Rev. 8:7)
 - 3. sea 2nd Trumpet: 1/3 sea turned to blood (Rev. 8:8)
 - 4. springs 3rd Trumpet: 1/3 springs (Rev. 8:10-11)
 - B. The Second Messenger the Middle of the 70th Week (Fall of Babylon Rev. 17-18)
 - 1. Vs. 8
 - a. Occurs BEFORE the second half (Dan. 7:11-12)
 - 1. 4th Beast is Roman Empire
 - 2. The 10 horns (Dan. 7:7) are 10 kings reigning simultaneously
 - a. ten toes on Nebuchadnezzar's image (Dan. 2:41-44)
 - b. ten kings burn the "Woman" (Babylon), and then give their dominion to Antichrist (Rev. 17:12-18).
 - 3. The Little Horn speaks pompous words, 4^{th} Beast BURNED, remaining beasts continue for a short time 2^{nd} half of Week (Dan. 7:11-12).
 - C. The Third Messenger the Second Half of the 70th Week
 - 1. Vss. 9-13
 - a. Those who take the mark, or worship the Beast:
 - 1. Drink the undiluted "wrath" of God"
 - 2. Tormented with the 7 bowls of wrath in view of the angels & Lamb.
 - 3. Smoke of torment ascends unto ages of ages. Sodom (Gen. 19:28)
 - a. Jude 1:7 example of age-enduring fire
 - b. Rev. 18:10,17,19,21 destruction of Babylon in "one hour"
 - 4. Promise to the faithful v. 12-13
