Lesson 51 – Rev. 20:7-9

- 1. Rev. 20 jumps 1k years from the "first resurrection" to the "general resurrection"
- 2. Rev 21-22 describes the KINGDOM in detail: "Kings and Priests" & Jerusalem restored
- 3. Rev. 20:7-10 Satan's last stand, and Rev. 20:11-15 are PARENTHETICAL
- III. Satan's Last Stand after the 1k years (Rev. 20:7-10)
 - 7 And when the thousand years should expire, Satan will be released from his prison.
 - 8 And he will come out to deceive <u>the nations which are in the four corners of the land</u>, Gog and Magog, to lead them together to the battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea.
 - **9** They went up across the [whole] width of the land, and surrounded the camp of the holy ones and the beloved city. And fire from God fell from the sky and consumed them.
 - A. Satan released from his prison, & deceives the nations
 - 1. Nations remain in the Kingdom for 1000 years.
 - a. Zech. 14:16-21 Nations remain
 - b. Isa. 65:17-25 Israel remains & children are born
 - c. Rev. 7:1-8 remnant of 12 tribes preserved from death / 9-17 the resurrected
 - 1. Rev. 11:1-2 worshipping at the Temple in the tribulation
 - 2. Rom. 11:25-29 Will be saved when "the Deliverer comes to Zion" (Isa. 59:20-21 LXX)
 - 3. Zech. 12:9-14 Redemption for Jerusalem when Christ arrives on earth.
 - B. "Gog, Magog"
 - 1. "Gog" a man's name another "Antichrist"
 - 2. The "land of Magog" (Gen. 10:2). "Magog" was son of Japheth (Noah's grandson) along with his brothers Meshech & Tubal. (settled north)
 - 3. "Gog" a prince of the descendants of Magog, prince of Rosh, Meshech, & Tubal (Ezek. 38:1 39:16) (N. Russia, Ukraine, Syria, Turkey; S. Libya, Ethiopia; E. Iran)
 - 4. Ham's descendants and other descendants of Japheth also mentioned in vss. 5-6.
 - C. Surrounded "the beloved city" (Psalm 78:67-69; Psalm 87:2; Psalm 132:13-15)
