Module XI – Revelation

Lesson 56 – Rev. 21-22

I. Chapter 21 cont.

- A. Vs. 4 "And He will wipe away every tear from their eyes;"
 - a. Isaiah 25:8 LXX "He will swallow up death in victory, The LORD God will wipe away tears from all faces" when the marriage feast occurs.
 - b. 1 Cor. 15:54 "So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: 'Death is swallowed up in victory'."
- B. Vs. 5 "Look! I am renewing everything ... these words are faithful and true."
- C. Vss. 6-7 The Father Himself promises:
 - a. To give of the "water of life" freely to the thirsty
 - 1. Baptism = immersion in and drinking in the Spirit/Breath (Acts 2:38; 1 Cor. 12:11-12)
 - 2. The "water of life" is a river supplying the "Tree of Life" (22:1-2)
 - b. The one being **victorious** will inherit these things as a son of God.
 - 1. Rev. 12:11 victorious = faithful to Jesus until death
- D. Vs. 8 The wicked "Gehenna," the "second death." (Isa. 66:24; Matt. 10:28)
- E. Vss. 9-11 The "Lamb's wife" is restored Jerusalem & her inhabitants
 - a. Called "the daughter of Zion" by the prophets
 - 1. (Zech. 2:10) "'Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion! For behold, I am coming and I will dwell in your midst,' says the LORD."
 - b. John taken to a high mountain to view same city as Ezekiel (40:2)
- F. Vs. 10 "descending out of the sky from God" an allegory depicting direct, divine intervention
- G. Vs. 11-13 The 12 gates named for 12 tribes (Ezekiel 48:31)
- H. Vs. 14 The 12 foundations named for **12 Apostles of <u>Iesus</u>** (limits to 12)
 - a. Paul included (Gal. 1:1) thus Matthias excluded (Acts 1:15-26)
- I. Vs. 15-16 The angel with the "measuring rod" length ???
 - a. σταδίος (masculine) means Greek race course of about 600'
 - b. σταδίον (neuter) means a fixed standard of measure.
 - c. Both are spelled $\sigma \tau \alpha \delta i \omega \nu$ in the genitive plural form.
 - d. The σταδίον (unit of measure) is deduced from comparing to Ezekiel
 - 1. Ezekiel $40.5 1 \text{ Rod} = 6 \text{ long} \text{ cubits (cubit}^{19"} + \text{span}^{5"}) = 24" \times 6 = a \frac{12' \text{ Rod}}{a}$
 - 2. Ezekiel 48:30-35 New Jerusalem $18,000 \text{ <u>rods</u>}^{\text{not cubits}}$ all around = 216,000 ft. (area of 105 sq. miles / 10.2 miles long on each side)
 - 3. John 12,000 "measures," (length of Angel's rod **NOT Greek race course**)
 - a. Ezekiel's 216,000' / 12,000 rods = 18' measuring rod
 - 4. Equal length, width, height = 54,000 ft. (10.2 miles high in elevation)
 - 5. Possibly a pyramid?
