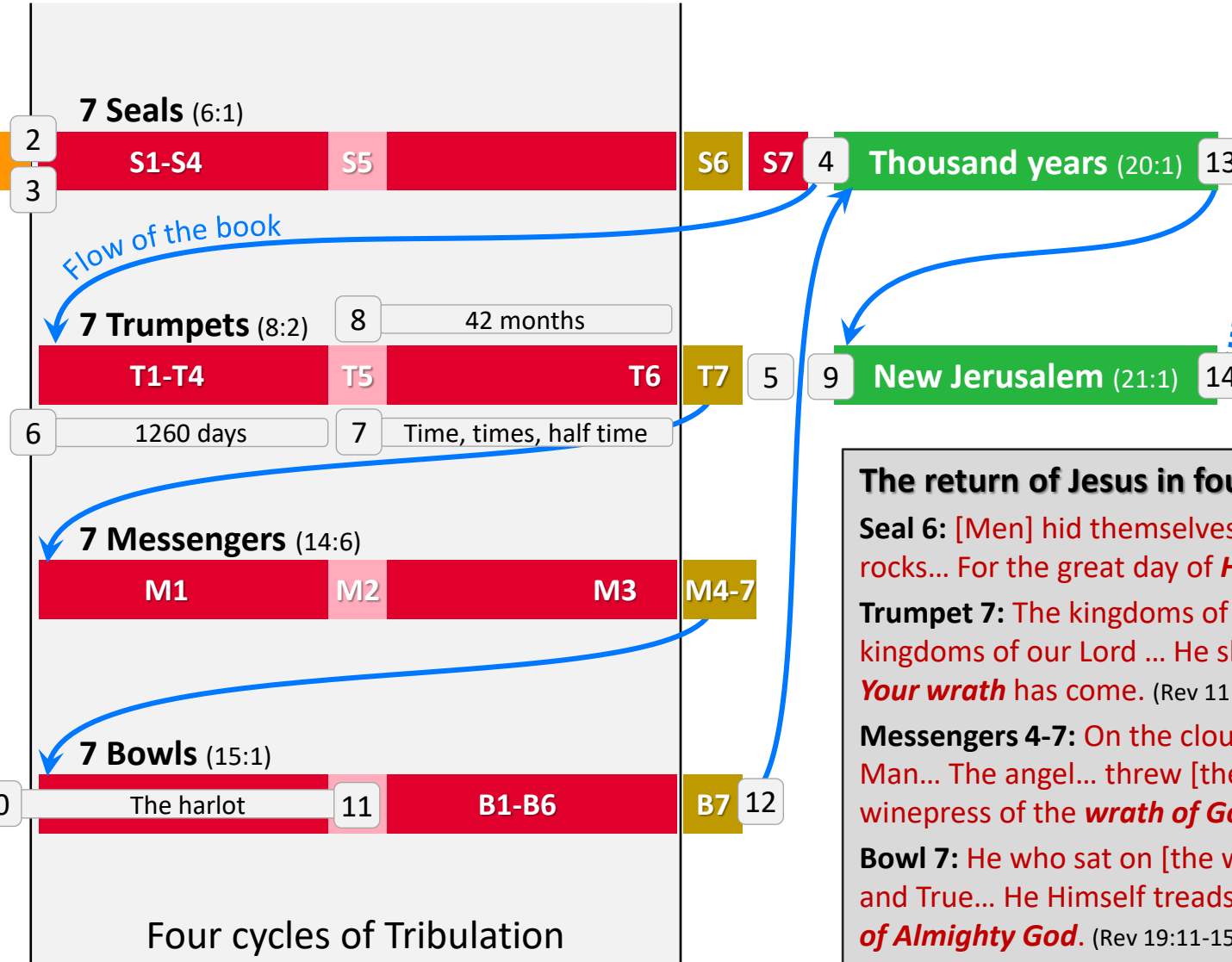

The return of Jesus in four versions

Seal 6: [Men] hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks... For the great day of *His wrath* has come. (Rev 6:15-17)

Trumpet 7: The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord ... He shall reign forever and ever... *Your wrath* has come. (Rev 11:15-18)

Messengers 4-7: On the cloud sat One like the Son of Man... The angel... threw [the vine] into the great winepress of the *wrath of God*. (Rev 14:14-19)

Bowl 7: He who sat on [the white horse] was called Faithful and True... He Himself treads the winepress of... the *wrath of Almighty God*. (Rev 19:11-15)
